2. WELCOME, LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND INTRODUCTIONS

The Calgary Board of Education acknowledges the traditional territories and oral practices of the Treaty 7 Nations, including the Siksikaitsitapi (Sig-sig-kaits-sits-a-pi), comprised of the Siksika (Sig-si-gah), the Kainai (Guy-nah), the Piikani (Bee-gah-nee), and the Amskapi Piikani (Ahm-skah-pee Bee-gah-nee) Nations. We acknowledge the Tsuut'ina (Soot-tenna) Nation, the Îyârhe Nakoda (Ae-yar-hay Na-koh-da), comprised of the Chiniki (Chin-ih-kee), Bearspaw, and Goodstoney Nations, the Métis Nation within Alberta, and all people who make their homes in the Treaty 7 region of southern Alberta.

5. PRINCIPAL/STAFF REPORT

• Administrative Update (Poppy Johnson)

- Smooth start to beginning of year
- We had a projection of 367 students for the 2025/2026 year, which would have required the addition of 2 new classes
- However, lower enrolment numbers translates to one FTE so that has resulted in needing to make some shifts to staffing; this was done to avoid the reduction of any of the teaching staff (Ms. Goldie is taking a leave for the year, one additional teacher is going to half-time and the Assistant Principal will be required to teach half-time to fill that open space)
- Initially we were down 36 students from what was expected but numbers have settled and we are now down only 27 students from the original projected numbers
- The new Assistant Principal will be announced within the next week

8. EXECUTIVE REPORTS

• Chair report (Miranda W)

- The Prince of Wales School Council is the structure where the school community discusses and supports school activities. The agenda for meetings is developed by the Council Executives and school administration with input from committees. Council sponsors social and family events throughout the year (Examples: Meet the Teachers/Icecream Social, Halloween family dance, Family Movie night, Staff appreciation etc) and works with the staff to co-sponsor other events (Examples: Terry Fox, Sports Day, Book Fair and Safety & Wellness committees). Other duties that fall under council's role include the organization of school volunteers, communication to the school community about events and Calgary Board of Education priorities and the cultivation of school culture and spirit. Council welcomes and encourages all parents to attend some or all of the council meetings. These meetings are informative and are a great way to participate in school priorities and to meet other parents.
- Annual Report was submitted to our Trustee Charlene May on June 30th, 2025
- We have had a busy start to September with a few things already happening in the school, so thank you to council executives and volunteers for making this happen for both the staff and students. (I dropped off Starbucks coffee & Cobs treats for staff August 28th, Thank you Terry Fox Volunteers Fun lunch volunteers today and all of those helping out at the Meet the teacher evening tomorrow night handing our Ice Cream.
- Our Team's membership is up on November 14th. This is before our November meeting. Leah has reached out to Microsoft Teams to ask if they will honor the last year's cost of \$85 because this year it would be \$115. Is this okay with the group if we move forward on this expense?
- Please contact us if you are interested in joining a specific committee: Secretary, Fun Lunch Coordinator, Staff Appreciation Team, Safety & Wellness Committee. Something new that we are offering to parents that join our council team this year: Fill any vacant roles on council and receive two front row seats to ONE of our spring performances. This has never been done before and Poppy also wants to offer to council executives currently holding a role on council the same benefit of two front row seats to ONE of the spring performance shows.

-You may have noticed on the agenda we have a time frame for all who have speaking points. This is to ensure we keep on track and respect other's time. If a topic or item gets brought up and we run out of time we will add it to our parking lot and come back to it at the end if time permits. If we don't have time at the end of the meeting this can be discussed further or be added to our next month's agenda.
